"Models of Governance of European Metropolitan cities and European Urban Agenda"

The City and the Metropolitan area of Milan intend to promote a debate on the future of the EU Urban policy and its key principles. It plans to do so through a partnership with the Cabinet of the European Commissioner for Regional Policy Ms Corina Crețu and a network of European metropolitan areas.

The City of Milan suggests building partnerships around some main topics:

- How to promote a metropolitan "brand"[in the EU urban policy;
- How to maximise EU funding opportunities and effectively manage EU grants of cities and metropolitan areas;
- How to defend the EU urban policy in the next EU budget

Building on the example of the Urban Agenda for the EU, these partnerships aim at allowing cities, Member States, EU Institutions and stakeholders, such as NGOs and business partners, to work together on an equal basis to find common ways to improve urban areas in the European Union policy
